Architectural Woodcarvings Win Coveted Platinum and Silver Awards for Design

Toronto, Canada: ADEX (Awards for Design Excellence), the largest and most prestigious awards program for product design of furniture, fixtures and finishes marketed to the design trade recently presented platinum and silver awards to Art For Everyday Inc.™ (AFE), a leading manufacturer of architectural woodcarvings.
